



MISSION: Covenant Mountain Mission Bible Camp



SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

Salem will be one of several volunteer teams that travel to CMMBC from June-August to help with youth summer camps and camp maintenance projects. Salem's team will be facilitating a soccer camp (grades K-12) and helping with maintenance projects the week of June 8-12. Please note there will be travel dates on the front and back end of this week.

TEAM PERSONELL

Our team can consist of up to 40 children and adult volunteers. Given that we have two types of teams going (soccer camp facilitators and maintenance abled people), there are ways for everyone to participate. We need individuals to coach the soccer camp; volunteers to host the camp by taking registrations; Bible teacher/leader; food service crew that will prepare daily meals and snacks; folks that will facilitate our children's programming for Salem children during the times (AM) they cannot participate in soccer camp; camp nurse; and maintenance abled workers.

Salem attenders will be given priority placement on the team; however, this trip is also open to non-Salem attenders as well (please see separate guidelines for this). Please note, team placement will not be considered until the required Salem application form and the \$25 trip deposit is submitted, which is requested by March 1, 2020 (see page 2).

SCHEDULE

Team members must arrive by the end of day on Saturday, June 6. This allows our team the opportunity to attend church together on Sunday and to prepare for the week. Camp is over on Friday, June 12, around 1:00 p.m. and team members are free to leave.

The soccer camp will run daily from 9am-1:00pm (middle and high school ages) and 5:30pm-8pm (elementary ages). The schedule for the maintenance team will be set closer to our arrival.

Salem's team members that are K-12 grades will be able to participate as a camper in the soccer camp. During the morning soccer camp (8-12 grades) in which many of our kids are not old enough to participate in, we will be designing and facilitating a VBS curriculum for them to participate in which will be led by Salem team members.

COST

The total **fixed** cost per person is estimated at **\$100**. Travel expenses to/from CMMBC, hotel stays, and eating out are the responsibility of the volunteer and are not included in these costs. Below are the costs associated with volunteering at CMMBC.

MEALS & LODGING

Meals and snacks are provided by CMMBC; Salem team members will prepare and serve the meals and snacks. A detailed menu will be provided during a CMMBC team meeting.

There are two air-conditioned housing units that we will stay in. They will have bunk beds with room capacities ranging from 2-6 people. We will have shared bathrooms. If we have more than 40 team members we can utilize the camper cabins and bathhouses, which are open air cabins (pretty rustic!).

TEAM MEETINGS

Your attendance at team meetings is required to participate in a Salem mission trip. These meetings are important for sharing trip information, getting acquainted with team members, and spiritually preparing to serve. Your team leader will set future team meeting dates.



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APPLICATION & PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- Complete Salem's GO:2020 Application Form and submit a \$25 non-refundable deposit¹ to Salem's Outreach Director, Shelli Streeper, by March 1, 2020. Checks should be written to Salem Covenant Church with "Team CMMBC" in the memo line.
- Final trip payment is due May 1, 2020.

¹ The registration deposit will be applied toward the individual's final trip expenses. If the individual becomes unable to participate due to personal reasons the deposit will be applied toward team expenses. If Salem declines participation for any reason, the deposit will be refunded to the individual.
