Foot Care Clinic

Salem hosts a foot care nurse on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month. Nicole Hendrickson has worked as an intensive care nurse and paramedic for almost 20 years, and she has channeled that care for human bodies into a career caring for client's feet.

Nicole offers the following services:

- Lower leg skin and foot exam
- Foot soak with an ultrasonic footbath
- Trimming and filing of toenails
- Reducing thick toenails
- Treatment for ingrown toenails
- Reducing calluses and corns
- Lower extremity skin care
- Light massage with lotion
- Education, recommendations, and referrals

Each appointment is scheduled for 45 minutes between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Cost is \$45 for the 45 minute appointment. Please mention you are from Salem when scheduling the appointment to receive the Salem price.

Caring Friends Ministry

The Caring Friends Ministry increases the church's ability to identify those needing care. Caring Friends can extend ministry to those in need, in addition to pastoral care from the pastors.

- Caring Friends are volunteers who commit to using their gifts and talents to serve homebound, sick, and troubled persons and assure them of God's love and the church's concern for them.
- Caring Friends Ministry volunteers do what a friend would do for a friend. They reach out to the person who needs occasional help or long-term support. This can take the form of visiting with individuals over the phone, through email, or in their homes.
- Their volunteer activity is structured and coordinated through the efforts of the Caring Friends Ministry coordinators.
